### AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS (ASD)

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) encompasses the diagnoses of Pervasive Developmental Disorder, Asperger Syndrome, as well as "classic" Autism.

ASD is a developmental disability that typically appears during the first three years of life. It has been estimated to occur in as many as 1 in 110 that is now diagnosed with autism.

Four times more prevalent in boys than girls, ASD knows no racial, ethnic or social boundaries.

ASD affects all types of families, regardless of income, lifestyle, and educational levels.

The result of the neurological disorder that affects normal brain development, Autism Spectrum Disorders impact the areas of social interaction and communications skills.

Children and adults with ASD typically have difficulties in verbal and nonverbal communications, social interactions, and leisure or play activities.
